LILY WECKS is a Portland based indie pop folk artist with a background in classical and jazz piano. On **June 3rd** she will be begin the launch of her debut album, with the release of her first single, the **title track - Lightning Bug.**

With heartfelt vocals and intentional lyrics, Lily tells stories of love, grief, and healing. Since childhood, Lily has been writing music to try and understand the world better. Currently, she is recording her debut album **“She Blessed My Bed”** with **producer Cameron Lavi-Jones of @kingyoungbloodmusic.** **She Blessed My Bed** – the album album comes Friday September 23, 2022.

The third signing of newly formed DICE LAB; a new breed artist co-op label, Lily’s work is largely motivated by her experience growing up as a bisexual woman in an evangelical environment, and the healing she has undertaken over the last few years, and she hopes to use her music to build community.
